Company to Present at Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce Conference

McCown, will present at the Puerto Rico Chamber of Commerce's "Investment for Growth" Conference in San Juan at the Ritz-Carlton on Wednesday, February 20, 2008. Mr. McCown's presentation will be part of a 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM local time panel on "Service, Retail & Communication" and will highlight the role the underlying trends in the marine lane will play in benefiting Puerto Rico's economic growth and its citizens. Among other items, he will discuss the strategic opportunities for Puerto Rico related to taking advantage of the ten million cubic feet of empty cargo space moving northbound each week and its environmental leadership in having the cleanest major marine lane in the world due to half the cargo moving on vessels using distillate fuel. The full day conference will include presentations by numerous business and government leaders and will be attended by many senior decision makers in both areas.
